“Jessamine County offers residents the chance to “clean up” their acts”

Tearing down an old shed and wondering what to do with the trash? Need somewhere to dump old newspapers and other trash you collected when cleaning up your basement? Jessamine County Environmental Services has the answer.

Any Jessamine County resident who wants to clean up their act – as in residential debris from their yard, basement, garage, etc. – will enjoy the free dumping offered during the 19th Annual County Wide Clean Up by Jessamine County Environmental Services at the Jessamine County Road Department, Longview Drive, Nicholasville, and Witt Lane, Wilmore.

Extended hours for the March 24-31 Saturday through Saturday, 7:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. Closed Sunday. No shingles, dry wall, or commercial debris will be accepted. No tree limbs or brush will be accepted. All wet paint cans must be mixed with sand and all tops removed. A fee will be charged for tire disposal.

Curbside pickup is available for county and City of Nicholasville residents.

From March 25-31, Jessamine County will also participate in Commonwealth Clean Up, a state-wide recycling and beautification effort that encourages local organizations and groups of residents to “adopt a road.” Garbage bags will be provided; groups will be directed to those county roads in need of adoption.
