Jessamine County Health Department has set dates for H1N1 vaccination clinics for Jessamine county residents. All clinics are by appointment only for persons in target groups established by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC's) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and will be held at the health department, located at 215 East Maple Street in Nicholasville. Appointments for the vaccine, which is free, may be made by calling the health department at 859/885-4149.

The target groups for H1N1 vaccination are as follows:

- pregnant women;
- persons who live with or provide care for infants aged <6 months (e.g., parents, siblings, and daycare providers);
- health-care and emergency medical services personnel;
- persons aged 6 months--24 years, and;
- persons aged 25--64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications.
